## Dublin's office boom slows due to Covid-19

Dublin's office market boom has slowed as a result of Covid-19.

In the week Google pulled out of a 200,000 sq ft letting at Mapletree's lettings in H1 2020. Sorting Office in Dublin, new research from property consultant HWBC predicted that take-up for the whole year would fall below 2m sq ft for the first time since 2012.

HWBCs H1 2020 Office Review showed take-up in the city in the first half of 2020 was down 36% compared with the same time last year.

The technology sector was the largest driver of demand for office. space in Dublin's market accounting for all top five

Rent levels for prime city centre space were reported at a steady €60 to €62/sq ft but were expected to soften.
